

AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

LIP BLUSH PROCEDURE



Final Lip Blush results depend greatly on how well you take care of your lips post-procedure. They will go through a fading phase and then reappear once the skin is fully healed. Any adjustments to color or shape can be made at your touch-up appointment. This process can be a bit of a roller coaster so please be patient for your final results. To assure you get the best results it is important to follow these instructions.

Please restrict your physical activities such as exercising, gardening, being in direct sun and recreational water activities (hot-tub, pool, Jacuzzi or going to the beach). Please also limit your exposure to pets for the first 24 hours as they can harbor bacteria and introduce it to your lips. Infection is possible if you do not keep the area clean.

Please apply Glossed Aftercare your lips after the first 6 hours while they heal. Do not use any saline, ointments or makeup while lips heal. Please avoid kissing and spicy foods for the first 7 days after treatment.

- *DO NOT rub or pick at the area.
- *DO NOT wax your lip until after they have healed.
- *DO NOT apply lipstick until they have healed.
- *DO NOT exercise for 3-5 days. This is crucial for the day of and after your procedure.
- *DO NOT swim or soak in a hot tub, jacuzzi, or pool until tattoo is completely healed. Showers are fine.
- *DO NOT tan for at least 10 days after treatment, this includes spray tans.
- *DO NOT use harsh cleansers or exfoliators on the area, including alcohol.
- *DO NOT receive a glycolic peel or laser treatment until 6 weeks after your treatment.
- *DO NOT let your lips dry out. It is very important to keep them moisturized with your lip balm.
- *Please DO use Glossed Aftercare on your lips while they heal. This will prolong their appearance.

Redness, light swelling and tenderness is common after your Lip Blush procedure. The following are signs and symptoms of minor infection and do not require medical attention: redness, swelling, painful and hot to the touch around the procedure site. Seek Immediate medical attention if you have any signs or symptoms of major infection such as: fever, streaking around procedure site or purulent drainage from procedure site.
